



Wildland Firefighter

Positions Available: Several call-when-needed and 4 seasonal wildland firefighters.

Red Rock Fire:

Red Rock Fire has been a leader in the wildland and prescribed fire community since 1995. Primarily an Engine company that responds nationally to wildland fire and all-hazard incidents. As of April 2017 Red Rock Fire was purchased by Minnesota Native Landscapes and is currently based out of Otsego MN. We are always accepting applications for Firefighters looking to gain experience and seasoned veterans willing to lead by example.

Position Description:

This position performs as emergency fire fighters to suppress and extinguish wildfires and work on prescribed fire projects within the state of Minnesota. If the applicant is qualified there will be opportunities to respond nationally.

Employment duration:

- This is irregular, short-term work; duration is based on fire danger & prescribed fire opportunity. (MN residency is not required)
- This position has the potential of part-time & full-time seasonal opportunities.
- This position has the potential of full-time permanent opportunities based on qualifications, experience & residency.

Compensation:

Based on the employee's qualifications & experience the pay scale will range from \$15.00 to \$22.00 per hour.

- Overtime after 40 hours within a pay period.
- Travel time will be compensated.
- Food & lodging will be provided or per diem will be paid for operations out of town or for overnights.

Required training & Qualifications includes:

- S-130 Basic Wildland Firefighter.
- S-190 Intro to Fire Behavior.
- L-180 Human Factors on the Fireline.
- IS-100 Incident Command System Overview.
- IS-700 National Incident Management System Overview.
- Must have current Refresher (RT-130). (Red Rock may provide training)
- High school diploma.

- Must have a valid driver's license. May be required to obtain a commercial vehicle health card (Medical Examiners Certificate)
- Must have the willingness to work long hours, day or night. Perform heavy physical work in variable weather conditions, at remote locations, on difficult and hazardous terrain, and under physically demanding circumstances.
- Must be able to pass a fitness test at the moderate or arduous level at the time of hire. (WCT can be locally administrated by Red Rock Fire)
- Must pass a background check and have no major traffic violations within the past three years.
